Chap.372

An Act Providing For The Regulation Of Weights Of Vehicles On Nantucket Island.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 1. Subject to the provisions of section two of chapter eighty-five of the General Laws, but notwithstanding any provision of the general law relative to the weight of vehicles on public ways, the board of selectmen of the town of Nantucket are hereby authorized to make regulations governing the weights of vehicles on ways within their control and fix penalties for the violation thereof, not to exceed twenty dollars for each offence. Such regulations shall not take effect until they have been published at least once in a newspaper in said town.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chapter 321. An Act Authorizing The Town Of Nantucket To Regulate The Dimensions And Number Of Certain Motor Vehicles Driven Or Operating In Said Town.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, the town of Nantucket is hereby authorized to adopt by-laws regulating the length, height and width of buses, tour buses, charter buses, common carriers of passengers by motor vehicles, or other such vehicles of more than ten passengers being driven or operating within the limits of said town.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
