About 'Stop the Bleed' and Bleeding Control Basics Course:

The 'Stop the Bleed' campaign was initiated by a federal interagency workgroup convened by the National Security Council Staff, The White House. The purpose of the campaign is to build national resilience by better preparing the public to save lives by raising awareness of basic actions to stop life threatening bleeding following everyday emergencies and man-made and natural disasters.

BleedingControl.org supports presidential policy directive for national preparedness (Presidential Policy Directive 8), which targets preparedness as a shared responsibility of the government, the private and non-profit sectors, and individual citizens.

This course is designed to train individuals on what to do as an immediate responder in a bleeding emergency and covers the ABCs of bleeding as a method to stop an active bleed. The course includes a class presentation and hands-on skills demonstration on tourniquet application, wound packing, and pressure application. Participants will also receive a certificate of completion upon completing the course.

Come learn simple, life saving skills under competent instructors from both the Nantucket Fire and Police Departments.
