Purpose: CNC's Extended Day Program offers high quality enrichment opportunities to elementary school children which focuses on learning new skills, fostering self-esteem, promoting team work and developing friendships. The Extended Day Program will remain on-site at the Nantucket Elementary School (NES) with the exception of special activities or field trips which may be scheduled throughout the year. Parents will be notified in advance to sign up their child for any special activity.

The typical day will follow a traditional after-school care option including snack, playground time, and age-appropriate activities involving arts and crafts, games, etc. Children enrolled in the Extended Day Program will meet in the NES Gymnasium when school is dismissed.

Pick-up is in the Kindergarten Cluster Area located near the NES cafeteria. The Pre-K program is offered to children enrolled in NPS's Magic Years, Pathways or young children of NPS staff and teachers. Children must be 2.9 years old at the beginning of the school year and potty trained. Parents must register/pay in advance for this program.

5:00 p.m. Final pick-up time

The extended Day Program will not be in session on any school holiday or half day with the exception of the half days the first week of school. Payment is due before the first day of each month. Registration begins June 1st for the following school year. Space is limited, register early. Registrations will be accepted at the CNC/NCS Office, Cyrus Peirce School, Room 02.

Purpose: To provide a safe and convenient mode of transportation for residents, seasonal employees, and visitors.

SERVICE/PROGRAM

The Nantucket Regional Transit Authority provides fixed route (The Shuttle) and advanced reservation door to door (Your Island Ride) transportation services.

Shuttle Services

Fixed route transportation is provided end of May to the beginning of October. Services are provided to/from town to the Mid-Island area, Sconset (via Old South Road, Milestone Road and Polpis Road), Madaket, Nantucket Memorial Airport, and Surfside and Jetties Beaches.

Mid Island Loop, Miacomet Loop, Madaket Route and Sconset via Old South Road Route operates throughout the shuttle season daily from 7:00 am to 11:30 pm. Sconset via Polpis Road Route operates July through Labor Day daily 10:00 am to 6:00 pm, Airport Route operates daily July through Labor Day 9:00 am. to 6:00 pm and Surfside and Jetties Beach Routes mid-June through Labor Day daily 10:00 am to 6:00 pm.

Fares: \$1.00 –Mid-Island Loop, Miacomet Loop, and Jetties Beach Route
\$2.00 Madaket Route, Airport Route and Sconset Routes. Various Pass Options are available.

Seniors 65 and older and persons with disabilities are half fare. Children 6 and under ride for free.

Stops are conveniently located along all routes, designated by grey posts with red and maroon stripes.

Park and Ride Lots are available at no cost at: Faregrounds Restaurant (7am-5pm); The Muse, The Chicken Box, Oddfellows Lodge; and Nantucket Elementary School (end of June – Labor Day).

All NRTA vehicles are lift equipped. All Shuttles can accommodate 2 bikes.

Year-round advanced reservation door to door transportation to eligible seniors 60 years of age and older and persons with disabilities Monday – Friday, 8:00 am. to 4 pm

Clients must be certified and determined eligible to use the service.

For information or to schedule a trip please call 508-325-7516.

Trips must be scheduled at least 24 hours in advance, no same day requests will be accepted.

Scheduled trips must be cancelled in advance; non-cancelled trips are subject to a fee.

Fares are \$1.00 each way in schedule and \$2.00 each way out of schedule. A three month pass for unlimited trips is available.
