

4. Specific sign types (cont.)

4.2 Construction and site signs

4.2.1 Definition

Construction Signs are temporary signs erected on the premises on which construction is taking place, during the time period of such construction, indicating the name of the architect, engineer, landscape architect, contractor, or similar artisans involved in the project. (See also Section 4.14)

4.2.2 Size

Construction signs shall not exceed one (1) square foot.

4.2.3 Placement

Construction signs shall be attached or affixed to a structure or building and shall not be freestanding.

4.2.4 Provisions

- A. Only one (1) construction sign is permitted per lot.
- B. Construction signs must be removed within thirty days of the substantial completion of work on site.
