To All Applicants:

The Nantucket Police Department is currently accepting applications from Massachusetts certified RESERVE POLICE OFFICERS for the 2012 Summer season. Reserve Officers are armed and perform a variety of duties and services in support of basic police operations and functions. Reserve Officers are generally assigned to bicycle, foot patrol and are scheduled to work day and night shifts. Officers are required to purchase their own uniforms to Department specifications. The Department does provide duty belts and other duty equipment other than basic uniform apparel. The starting hourly rate for is \$15.00 per hour. Housing for the summer is available for \$95.00 per week.

The hiring process consists of a criminal background check, oral interview and a physical examination. The interviews are scheduled to occur during the first two weeks of April. For successful applicants, there will be a training program scheduled to start on June 4, 2012 and then employment will continue through Labor Day. Under certain circumstances, such as exam conflicts, your starting date may be modified. If you are requesting a start date change, you must provide a written explanation of the conflict. Hiring preference may be given to those applicants who can start on June 4. You can either print or complete the application on your computer. It is suggested that you use Adobe Acrobat Reader to complete the application. The deadline for completed applications to be mailed with ORIGINAL signatures is March 3, 2012. FAX copies will not be accepted.
