

Goals and Issues for HSAB in 2010-2011

- 1. Contribute to Shellfish Management Plan (SMP) (1 years – April 2011)**
 - A. Support SMP Committee
 - B. Monitor progress
- 2. Monitor Effects of Harmful Algal Blooms (HABs)**
 - A. Ensure protocol is in place to monitor and sample HAB if it appears
 - B. Help coordinate efforts of all groups involved
- 3. Support Harbor Plan Oversight Committee (Ongoing)**
 - A. Schedule semi-annual report of progress on HSAB-related issues
 - B. Report to BOS if action needed
- 4. Support Article 68 Workgroup (Ongoing)**
 - A. Get periodic reports from HSAB representative
 - B. Provide input to them when appropriate
- 5. Monitor Harbor Water Quality Program (Ongoing)**
 - A. Follow sampling results throughout year
- 6. Follow progress of Town's Propagation and Research Efforts (Ongoing)**
 - A. Get periodic reports from Town Shellfish Biologist
- 7. Collect Research on Harbors, Water Quality, and Shellfish (June 2010)
(Harbor Plan Recommendation)**
 - A. Get list of projects from all participants
 - B. Get abstracts of projects, copies of final reports and mount on Harbor Website
 - C. Improve access to past reports and data
- 8. Follow Propagation Fund Budget (Ongoing)**
 - A. Understand current expenses and income
 - B. Regularize guidelines for expenditures – if needed
- 9. Follow progress of, and support grant proposals from all sources.**
- 10. Follow and Support the Nantucket Marine Collaborative and Boathouse Plans**
- 11. Encourage public understanding of Harbor issues (ongoing)**
 - A. See that "Harbor Website" is maintained; with information about problems, regulations, research programs, publicly available data, etc.
 - B. Encourage media coverage of Harbor issues
 - C. Require public dissemination of results of HSAB funded research
 - D. Encourage people to run for HSAB
