

The MSPCA is the primary emergency shelter for your pets. The MSPCA is open on Friday regular hours, 8am to 6pm. If you need to [bring your pet to the MSPCA](#) during the night time hours, someone will be in the building and will answer the bell located on the outside of the building. You can call the MSPCA's regular business line 508-228-1491, someone will be there to answer your call. Please do not call the on call vets as they are for medical emergencies only.

If you bring your pet to the MSPCA there are a few things to know and do.

1. Make sure to write your name, address and phone numbers on a piece of paper. Other important information to include would be; what kind of food, how much the pet gets and how many times a day your pet gets its food. If your pet takes medication please write down what it is. Please include a photo ID of your pet with you paper work.
2. Make sure your pet is on a leash or in a carrying case before arriving at the MSPCA. Please bring all food and medication with you to the MSPCA. Please do not bring any bedding or kitty litter boxes to the MSPCA.
3. If you leave your pet at home make sure your pet has a collar with ID tags in case your pet gets out. Leave your pet in a safe area with enough food and water for about 5 days. Please do not leave your pets in a basement or tied inside or outside, due to flooding. Leave a note taped to the inside of a glass window closes to the main door stating if there are pets in the house.
4. The MSPCA cannot handle any domestic farm animals so please make sure all animals are moved inside with plenty of water and hay. Make sure you have enough water and food to last a couple of days. Ensure all fencing is secure and leave all halters on your animals in case they get free. Write a phone number on the halter so we can call you if you animals should get out. If a large animal needs to be evacuated please call the Police Station.
