

Dear Conservation Commission, This letter is from Michael Carey and Fariha Khan and we live at 1 Mariner Way, a home that is on the Abutter's List for 2 Mariner Way.

We are writing to express our strong opposition to the proposed plan to remove an approved garage and install a pool at 2 Mariner Way. As a member of the community, I am deeply concerned about the potential negative impact this would have on the neighborhood.

Firstly, the proposed addition of a pool is a significant change from the originally-approved plan submitted by a different owner. This change is not a minor amendment and would have material consequences for the community. The pool would exacerbate flooding in the area, which is already a significant problem, especially for properties located in a flood zone like mine.

Secondly, the chemicals involved in maintaining a pool, whether fresh or saltwater, pose a serious threat to the natural resources in the vicinity. The wetlands, the Duck/Goose Pond, and the Harbor are all vulnerable to contamination from these chemicals, which would harm the plants and animals in our neighborhood.

Lastly, I urge the Conservation Commission to reject this request because it goes against the spirit of protecting our natural habitat. If the proposal is approved, it sets a precedent for other developers to follow suit, which would lead to the destruction of this precious ecosystem.
