

Virtual Meetings with VOYA

TASC Flexible spending accounts - Carryover increase

Notice 2020-33 increases the \$500 limit for unused amounts remaining in a health FSA that may be carried over into the following year by making the carryover amount 20% of the maximum salary reduction amount under § 125(i), which is indexed for inflation.

Thus, for **2020**, the **carryover** amount will **increase** to \$550.
